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Permission was accorded for classes I to VII (EM) during year 2017-18 vide Dist Educational Officer, proceedings under reference 9<sup>th</sup> cited, in respect of MSR Central School (E.M) Durajpally Village , Chivvemla (M), Suryapet Dist.

The Mandal Educational Officer, Chivvemla , Suryapet District has recommended to accord provisional recognition for the classes I to VII (EM), for the academic year 2017-18 to 2026-27 through the 8<sup>th</sup> cited.

After careful examination of the proposals from the society and also as per the Inspecting Officer recommendation under reference 8<sup>th</sup> cited and in terms of the orders issued in the reference 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> cited, the District Educational Officer, Suryapet District is hereby accord Provisional Opening Permission to classes I to VII (EM) during the 2017-18 to 2026-27 in respect of MSR Central School (E.M) Durajpally ,(V) Chivvemla (M), Suryapet Dist. And instructed to follow the below instructions.

1. That the society shall abide to the rules and regulations made in the Govt. Order 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> cited.
2. That the society shall provide the necessary amenities like accommodation, sanitary facilities, drinking water facilities, furniture, library, laboratory equipments, play field, required staff as per the pattern and other facilities are necessary before approaching the competent authority.
3. That the permission accorded is restricted to the same year only.
4. That this permission does not confer any right on the society for claiming reorganization. .
5. That the permission to accorded to Sri Venkateshwara Educational Society and no other society or body can open a school their behalf..
6. The permission is accorded to open the school premises in the locality and there shall not be any change in the premises or locality.
7. The society shall provide the necessary material even it is cost more than the deposit amount.
8. Proper and adequate parking area for vehicles shall be provided transporting the children to and fro the school.
9. Proper sanitation facility shall be provided for students especially for girl students..
10. Proper and adequate safety measures shall be taken for children within the school campus and also near the school premises.
11. The school follow the traffic and safety guidelines indicated by the police and fire services department.
12. The parent teachers associations meeting shall be conducted to sensitize the parents on the safety of the children.
13. The school shall have first aid kit and the teachers shall be treated in first aid..
14. The above permission is accorded purely on a temporary basis and is subjected to the reports of the State Level Inspection and Vigilance Committee fulfilling of all the perquisite condition under the A.P. Education Act 1982 and if later found that the school has not fulfilled any perquisites as stipulated, the permission now being given is liable to be withdrawn at once.
15. That the Educational Society shall bellow the Examination schedule as per the time table issued by the Quarterly, Half yearly, Annual and Pre-final examinations.
16. The society shall provide, the necessary material even if it is costs more than the deposit.
17. That the Educational Society shall not conduct any events for children which will harm to lives.
18. That the Educational Society shall not conduct classes on public holidays/summer holidays/short term holidays without permission from the undersigned.
19. That the Educational Society should constitute parents teachers committee and should conduct meetings with a committee once in a month.
20. That the Educational Society should not open counters for selling books/badges/stationery etc.,




21. That the Educational Society should follow school timings as prescribed by Government in school academic calendar.
22. That the Educational Society shall not conduct any events for children which harm to lives.
23. That the Educational Society shall not conduct classes on public holidays. summer holidays/short term holidays without permission from the undersigned.
24. That the Educational Society should constitute parents teachers committee and should conduct meetings with a committee once in a month.
25. That the Educational Society should not open counters for selling books/badges/stationery etc.
26. That the Society /school shall abide by the provisions of Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act,2009 and the rules there of.
27. That the school management shall admit in class 1, to the extent of 25% of the strength of that class, children belonging to weaker sections and disadvantaged groups in the neighborhood and provide free and compulsory classes also, its norm shall be followed.
28. That the society/school shall not collect any capitation fee and subject the child or his or her parents or guardians to any screen procedure.
29. That the management shall not deny admission to any child
  - a).for lack of age proof if such admission is sought subsequent to the extended period prescribed for admission
  - b). on the ground of religion, caste or race, place of birth or any of them.
30. No child admitted be held back in any class or expelled from school till the completion of elementary education in a school.
31. No child shall be subjected to physical punishment or mental harassment;
  - i).No child is required to pass any board examination till the completion of elementary education
  - ii)Every child completing elementary education shall be awarded a certificate as laid down under Rule 23
  - iii) Inclusion of students with disabilities/special needs as per provisions of the Act
  - iv) The teachers are recruited with minimum qualification as laid under section 23 (1) of the Act provided further that the current teachers who, at the commencement of this Act do not possess minimum qualifications shall acquire such minimum qualification within a period of 5 years
  - v) The teachers perform his/her duties specified under section 24(1) of the Act and
  - vi) The teachers shall not engage himself in private teaching activities.
  - vii) That the management of school shall enroll students proportionate to the facilities available in the school as prescribed in section 10 of the Act
  - viii) That the management of school shall maintain the standards and norms of the school as specified in section 19 of the Act
32. No un-recognized classes shall run within the premises of the school or outside in the same name of the school.
33. That the building or other structures or the grounds are not used during the day or night for commercial or residential purposes (Except for the purpose of residence of any employee of the school) or for political or non-educational activity of any kind whatsoever.
34. That the school is run by society registered under the Societies Registration Act 1860(21 of 1860) or a public trust constituted under law for the time being in force,
35. That the school is not run for profit to any individual group of Association of individuals or any other persons..
36. The accounts. Should be audited and certified by Chartered Accountant and proper accounts statements of Accounts should be sent to the District Educational Officer every year.
37. The permission through DEO,Suryapet Rc.No. 6282/C2/2017 , Dt 30.06..2017.
38. The school furnish such reports and information as may be required by the Rajiv Vidya Mission/ District Educational Officer from time to time and complies with such instructions of the State Government /Local Authorities as may be issued to secure the continued fulfillment of the condition of recognition or the removal of deficiencies in working of the school.
39. The permission shall be withdrawn if the contravention of the provisions of the Act. The Rules and conditions of the recognition is found and proved.
40. The management of the school should follow the instructions if any issued for Renewal Recognition of Upper Primary Schools in future they should also abide by the rules / instructions issued by the government from time to time.



After careful examination of the references cited and the conditions prescribed in G.O. Ms. No.1/Edn, (PS.2) Dept, dt.01.01.1994 the Regional Joint Director of School Education, Hyderabad is hereby accorded Provisional Recognition to Class(es) VIII to X (E.M) for the years 2019-2020 to 2028-2029 in respect of M.S.R..Central High School Durajpally (V)Chivemla (M), Suryapet Dist. subject to fulfillment of conditions as detailed below:

1. That the Educational Society shall abide by the instructions/rules issued by the Govt. from time to time.
2. That the educational Society shall serve the needs of locality more particularly.
3. That the institution shall adopt the curriculum and syllabus prescribed from time to time by the State Government.
4. That the school timings, vacations and mid-term holidays shall be as prescribed by Govt. from time to time.
5. That the qualified staff within age limits prescribed by the Govt. for Government employees shall be appointed as per the staff pattern as per G.O Ms.No.103 Edn (PS), dt.05-08-2005.
6. That the results shall be satisfactory every year and not to be announce the ranks in SSC Public Examinations as per the G.O Ms.No.49 Edn. (PS), dt.26.02.98.
7. That the records/accounts shall be furnished to the D.E.O every year by 31<sup>st</sup> March, at the latest.
8. That the list of governing body shall be furnished to the DEO every year.
9. That the pay structure / fee structure fixed by the governing body shall be got approved by the DEO every year.
10. That all the conditions prescribed in G.Os and other orders which are not specified in this order shall complied with.
11. That the school shall not be closed without giving notice both the Parents/DEO and competent authority at least (6) months before.

12. That the school shall be closed or permitted to be closed only from the date on which summer vacation is declared.
13. That the society shall submit proposals for renewal of provisional recognition sufficiently in advance i.e., at least (6) months prior to the date of expiry of the renewal.
14. That additional sections/higher classes should not be opened without prior permission of the competent authority.
15. That the recognition is accorded to society and no other society or body can open a school on their behalf.
16. The recognition is accorded to open the school premises in the locality and there shall not be any change in the premises or locality.
17. The society shall provide the necessary material even if it costs more than the deposit amount.
18. Admissions should be made on the basis Record sheet issued by the Private Recognized/ZP/Govt/Aided schools only T.Cs/Certificates issued by the Secretary, DCEB as Bonafide candidate.
19. The Edn. Society shall file an affidavit to the effect that there is no deviation or violation of norms/rules prescribed by Govt. from time to time by the end of April every year as per G.O.6<sup>th</sup> cited.
20. The above E.T.R. is granted subject to condition that, If it is found later that the school has not fulfilled the prerequisite condition under A.P. Edn. Act 1982, reported by State Level Inspection Team and Vigilance Committee, the E.T.R. now being granted is liable to be withdrawn at once.
21. The Management shall provide sufficient transportation, sufficient fire extinguishers in the school.
22. The Management is totally responsible in all aspects for the safety of school children. They will be personally held responsible if any incident occurs.
23. The Management shall handover the school premises whenever required to this department / Government for emergency purpose (Exams/ Elections etc.) without any deviation of the orders.
24. G.O.Ms.No.22,dt18.07.2017 must be compulsorily followed i.e., the weight of school bag not to exceed 4 Kg for VI-VII, 4.5 Kg for VIII-IX and 5 Kg for X.
25. The Management not to run I.I.T and Medical entrance foundation courses as permission of Renewal Recognition is given only for school.
26. Sanitary & Soundness Certificate should be renewal timely and must be submitted to the District Educational Officer concerned.
27. The Correspondent is instructed to Renewal lease deed time to time when it's get expired.
28. TPF Scheme should be implemented to all teachers.
29. The Management should renew Fire (NOC) time to time without fail.

The recognition now granted is liable for withdrawal by the competent authority for violating the rule as prescribed in the G.O 5<sup>th</sup> cited and instructions issued by the authority from time to time.
